







Located next to a fenced playground, basketball court and grassy play area, this rentable space includes a covered pavilion with four picnic tables.

In this area, a covered pavilion provides shade for four picnic tables, three barbecues, sand volleyball courts, and restrooms. Electricity is available for an additional \$25. Jumpers are accepted and may be booked separately, with a \$25 fee, plus insurance.
